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New Library



Something really exciting happened this week in school - we had our library refurbished! Thanks to our amazing PTA, we have been able to refit the library to make it an enticing place for children to explore, discover and enjoy reading books. We love reading at Bottisham Primary and are so proud that we now have a library environment that reflects this! A big thank you to Mrs Walker and all her helpers who have spent much of this week moving boxes of books around and filling the new shelves ready for the first visitors to enjoy the wonderful texts we have available.

Attendance reminder



We believe that for pupils to progress and achieve their full potential they need to have a good level of attendance at school. As a result, pupil attendance is monitored and analysed regularly throughout the

school year to help us identify when poor attendance is becoming an issue, understand the reasons for absence and to offer families support to improve it.

Local Authority guidance states that schools should notify parents when a child's attendance falls below 96%. Last term, this was done at the parent consultation evening when class teachers shared the children's attendance as part of the discussion and highlighted where attendance levels had fallen below the expected 96%.

This term a letter of notification will be sent home to inform you if you child's attendance has fallen below the expected level, even when the absences are authorised (e.g. due to illness). In most cases, no further action will be required. We recognise that many parents may be concerned if they receive a letter due to absence through illness which is of course, unavoidable, but it is important that we keep you informed of your child's attendance levels.

If your child's attendance has fallen below 90% so far this academic year, we may be in contact with you to have a conversation about the reasons for the absence and if appropriate, offer support.

In relation to term time holidays, please be aware that these will only be authorised in exceptional circumstances. The County Council expectation is that all schools in Cambridgeshire will make a referral for a Fixed Penalty Notice for term time leave – i.e. unauthorised absences. These may be actioned for 8 non-consecutive unauthorised absences over an 8 week period or 6 consecutive unauthorised absences over a 3 day period (1 day is classed as 2 sessions – morning and afternoon). Therefore, if you take you child out of school for a holiday of more than three days which is not authorised, you may be issued with a Fixed Penalty Notice.

We support and expect parents to keep children away from school where they may be infectious to other children, or because they are feeling just too unwell to be able to attend. Maintaining a dialogue with the school during periods of absence really helps to ensure that we are aware that the child has a legitimate reason for being absent, and that parents can seek clarification or support where they need it.

We know that you recognise the importance of regular attendance at school and the impact this has on your child's education, friendship groups and their life chances. Thank you for your continued support in ensuring your child attends school regularly.

Well done Year 6!



A huge well done to all the children in Y6 who took part in the SATs last week. We were blown away with the mature approach demonstrated by all the pupils towards the tests. They tried their best and made us incredibly proud in the process. Thank you to all the adults involved in supporting the Y6 children throughout the week and to the PTA for providing a wonderful SATs breakfast each day - it was a brilliant way to start the day in a fun and relaxed way.


Are you worried about a child, family or friend?
