Gross motor skills - outside running, climbing, jumping.
Fine motor skills - Investigates mark making/early writing using thumb and fingers to hold pencil (no longer using whole hand grip)

Recognising and managing risk

Managing toileting and washing hands independently

Independently putting on socks, shoes and coat.

## Communication and Language

Maintaining focus and attention during carpet time and adult-led activities.

Developing vocabulary and using more complex sentences. Expressing own needs and feelings appropriately

Making predictions and responding to 'how?' and 'why?' questions
