Topic Overview

Google Classroom

Google Classroom continues to be a vital resource for staff, pupils and parents, as a way to set and upload homework as well as share messages with you and learning in the classroom.

Homework will be set on a Friday and is expected to be handed in by Wednesday morning. Students will be given printed homework, which should be returned in their homework book. Assignments will also be posted on Google Classroom for your reference. We expect children to be spending around half an hour on English and the same on maths. Obviously, some children might complete it quicker than this, but if your child has been focussed for this length of time and has not finished, then a note in your child's homework book to highlight what they were finding difficult is welcome and perfectly acceptable. Children will also have spellings to work on each week.

Mystery Book- After half term, each class will have a mystery reading book to take home. Each child will take it in turns to take home the mystery book, read and enjoy it (with or without you!) and write a little something in the class book for the next person to see. They must try and keep the identity of this book a secret!

Reading at home



As a school we are always promoting reading and the skills of comprehension which are needed to fully access and enjoy a good book. Please remind your child to read daily Once they have completed a book, we ask them to complete a quiz about it on Accelerated Reader.

Please check your child has these in school every day. All children are expected to change shoes so they can enjoy the field and outdoor area as much as possible all year round. We have been seeing an increase in children without changes of shoes which is leading to problems with excessive mud in the corridors and classrooms. Indoor shoes are essential during the school day, as we cannot have children in bare feet, and must be named and worn when inside.
