

Programming


Pupils will be taught about:

Pupils will be taught about:

- The history of portraits exploring famous portrait artists.
- Influences on these artists
- Developing their shading techniques to support their final piece

Design and Technology

Design and make a healthy pizza

Pupils will be taught to

- understand and apply the principles of a healthy and varied diet
- prepare and cook a variety of predominantly savoury dishes using a range of cooking techniques
- understand seasonality, and know where and how a variety of ingredients are grown, reared, caught and processed

Mathematics

Pupils will learn using mixed age planning of Year 3/4 objectives.

Science

Rocks

Pupils will be taught about:

- Compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties
- Describe in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rock
- Recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter

Religious Education

Children will learn about:

Festivals and celebrations in different faiths and explore the question - **Why are they important? What is celebrated?**
