



<p>Mathematics</p> <p>We are continuing to follow the  'White Rose' maths scheme and during this term, we will complete four topics:</p> <p>To 20 and Beyond (Building numbers and counting patterns beyond 10, Spatial Reasoning, Match, Rotate and Manipulate)</p> <p>First, Then, Now (Adding more, Taking away, Spatial Reasoning, Compose and Decompose)</p> <p>Find My Pattern (Doubling, Sharing and Grouping, Even and Odd, Spatial Reasoning, Visualise and Build)</p> <p>On the Move (Deepening Understanding, Patterns and Relationships, Spatial Reasoning, Mapping)</p>	<p>Personal, Social and Health Education</p> <p>We will be looking at different ways of 'Keeping Safe' and later in the term 'My Body and Growing Up'.</p>	<p>Expressive Arts and Design</p> <p>We will also be creating some exciting artwork linked to our topics, experimenting with different materials and techniques.</p> <p>We will be listening to and learning some songs related to our topics</p>
<p>Literacy</p> <p></p> <p>During the term, we will be working on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - News writing - Non-Fiction texts - Developing reading and comprehension skills - Drama and role play - Learning new sounds in phonics - Applying phonics to writing words and sentences 	<p>Communication and Language</p> <p>The children will have opportunities to listen attentively in a range of situations and respond to what they have heard.</p> <p>They will develop their vocabulary by hearing new words in the context of their learning.</p> <p>They will be encouraged to use full sentences when they are speaking and to use the past, present and future tenses correctly.</p>	<p>Physical Development</p> <p>The children will practise building strength, balance and co-ordination and will be learning basic skills in sending and receiving using a variety of equipment. They will also develop their fine motor skills, so that they can use a pencil, scissors and paint brushes with care and accuracy.</p> <p>Understanding the World</p> <p>The children will learn about similarities and differences between things in the past and now.</p> <p>We will discuss the changing seasons, noticing the signs of Spring and then Summer.</p> <p>The children will have opportunities to observe changes in nature, looking closely at frogspawn becoming tadpoles and caterpillars becoming butterflies.</p>
